SENIOR LADIES CHAMPIONSHIPS OF ENGLAND

2016 Competition Rules and Conditions

These Rules and Conditions are additional to the Rules on Dress Code and General Rules for all Association Competitions

Format

1. The competition is open to senior lady amateur golfers. It comprises a singles stableford event and simultaneously, an aggregate pairs stableford event. Play will be stableford over 18 holes from the medal tees.

Entry and Draw

2. Clubs may enter as many players and/or teams as they wish. Alternatively, players who are members of affiliated clubs may enter directly.
3. Duly completed entry forms and all fees to be received by the Competition Organiser by the set closing date. In addition to the entry fee those entering will be responsible for the payment of their green fees.
4. Two players entering from the same Club may form a team and enter the team event by paying the appropriate team entry fee.

Conditions of Play

5. For the purpose of this competition the term senior refers to ladies who have reached the age of 50+ on or before the day of play.
6. The maximum permitted handicap is 36 with players entitled to their full handicap allowance.

Trophies and Prizes

7. At the National Final the player with the most stableford points will be awarded the Barbara Rainey Bowl. The team with the highest aggregate stableford points will be awarded the Reg Pugh Shield. In addition the winners of the trophies will also be awarded a prize.
8. The winner of the individual trophy will be granted entry to the following year's Championship in order to defend her title, subject to still being a playing member of a club affiliated to the NAPGC.
9. Other prizes at the National Final will be awarded in relation to the number of entries received and at the discretion of the Competition Organiser.
